

Privacy Statement for the BusLink Survey Draw 2024

What this statement covers

The Northland Regional Council (NRC) has created this privacy statement to explain how we handle your personal information collected through the BusLink survey draw. Our collection, use, and disclosure of your personal information comply with the Privacy Act 2020.

What personal information do we collect and how will we use it?

We collect the first name, age, and contact information (email address or phone number) of participants entering the draw. The provision of this information is voluntary; however, if you do not provide the requested information, your entry will not be valid.

Using your information

We will only use the personal information provided for the purposes outlined above and for other reasons permitted by the Privacy Act 2020.

Data storage, security, and access

NRC has implemented measures to ensure your personal information is kept safe and secure against loss, damage, misuse, and unauthorized access.

Sharing your information

Your personal information will not be shared with third parties except as necessary to administer the draw or as required by law.

How long do we hold your personal information?

We will retain all personal information collected only until 12 December 2024.
